# Question #1 Received on November 8th, 2023 at 4:31 PM:

The ITB asks that we submit Bid, Payment, and Performance bonds with our final submittal. Typically, we submit a bid bond with the proposal and submit payment and performance bonds upon reward. Is this okay?

### **Response to Question #1:**

Only the selected landscape maintenance contractor will be required to submit the Payment and Performance Bond. The CID will provide direction the selected contractor as to when the P&P bond is to be submitted.

The 5% Bid Bond is required to be submitted when the bid is submitted.

### Question #3 Received on 11/16/2023 at 3:345 PM:

- 3.A Is all of the hard wood mulch located at Mountain Industrial Blvd for the crepe myrtle tree wells, medians and at the interchange?
- 3.B. Do you have mulch counts for what has been previously put down?
- 3.C. In Exhibit C Table 2 there are some locations listed that need mowing but Table 1 in exhibit B says that there isn't any mowing.

- 3.D. Do we need to refer only to Table 1 for mowing frequencies? Example: Rock Mountain Blvd, Roadhaven Drive, South Royal Atlanta Drive, Tuckerstone Pkwy, CC. North Royal Atlanta Drive
- 3.E. In Exhibit D Table 3 (Herbicide and Fertilizer Treatment) for the guardrails in the TSCID, do we need to fertilize those areas eight times per year?

## Response to Question #3:

- 3.A. No. Tree wells with red hardwood mulch are also located on East Ponce de Leon
- 3.B. No.
- 3.C. That is an incorrect statement. Both tables are consistent in terms of which roads are areas are to be mowed.
- 3.D. Unsure what is meant by the question? There are 14 areas to be moved. These are described in Exhibit B Table 1 and Exhibit C Table 2.
